# California businesses dominate the Inc. 5000 list

The Inc. 5000 companies have generated 874,940 jobs and \$317 billion in revenue over three years, with median revenue growth of 1,637%. California topped the list with 672 companies, including six companies in the national top 20.

California companies ranged from storage services for travelers throughout the globe to a cyber insurance pioneer to clean energy solutions for homeowners. California's dominance of the

Inc. 5000 list is another indication of California's economic strength. World's fifth largest economy

California is the 5th largest economy in the world for the seventh consecutive year, with a nominal GDP of nearly \$3.9 trillion in 2023 and a growth rate of 6.1% since the year prior, according to the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis. On a per capita basis, California is the second largest economy in the world among large economies.

Highest level of tourism spending

*"California has the most dynamic, entrepreneurial economy in the country. Businesses that start and grow here change the world. It's why we're the 5th largest economy in the world and continue creating more jobs than any other state."*

California has the largest market share of tourism in the nation. Travel spending in the state reached an all-time high of \$150.4 billion last year, surpassing the record \$144.9 billion spent in 2019 – spending that is 3.8% higher than 2019 and 5.6% higher than 2022.

The new travel-spending record generated \$12.7 billion in state and local tax revenue by visitors in 2023, marking a 3% increase over 2019. Tourism created 64,900 new jobs in 2023, bringing total industry employment to 1,155,000.

### Thousands of fast food jobs created

According to the latest state and federal employment data, California has more fast food jobs

than ever before, boasting over 750,000 jobs as of July 2024. And, the industry has added jobs every month this year.

### Most companies on the Fortune 500 list

For the first time since 2014, California is home to the most Fortune 500 companies in the country – beating out Texas, Florida, and all other states. From tech to finance to entertainment, the state's diverse economy has 57 companies on the list, while Texas and New York are tied in second with 52 companies each.

# Opportunities for Small and Minority Owned California Businesses

### In summary

*The Equity in Infrastructure Project has helped companies like Global Electric as billions of federal dollars flow into California infrastructure projects.*

Being a business owner was always part of the dream for William Jackson, president and founder of Global Electric.

He launched the electrical contracting firm in 2006 and built it up to 25 employees, taking on public works projects in the Los Angeles area and beyond with clients including the city, county, LA Metro, and Metrolink. The team is currently working on light rail vehicle projects and making improvements to stations and platforms for LA Metro.

As a certified small, minority, and disadvantaged business, Global Electric is the type of contractor that public agencies are supposed to be

leveling the playing field for when it comes to competing for work. Winning a contract is still rife with hurdles for small businesses, though, from qualifying for various bonds — essentially promising the contractor will meet the project requirements — to having the right insurance.

These are some of the barriers the Equity in Infrastructure Project is trying to dismantle in California and across the country, especially as money pours into public infrastructure projects following the \$1.2 trillion federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021. California has already received more than \$42 billion of those funds.

Denver International Airport CEO Phillip A. Washington and others started the organization in 2021 with the goal of creating more opportunities for small, minority-, women- and veteran-owned businesses. The vision is to build generational wealth and reduce the racial wealth gap by breaking down barriers to contracting opportunities, Washington said.

The Equity in Infrastructure Project is building a coalition of public agencies and private sector companies to support its work. More than 60 infrastructure-related businesses and public agencies, such as airports, ports, water districts, and state departments of transportation have joined.

Public agencies that sign the project's pledge set a baseline against which they will measure themselves through December 2025. They are asked to submit information on their existing contracting efforts, including any category of historically underutilized businesses — such as disadvantaged, small, minority-, women- and veteran-owned businesses — for which they accept certifications or have targeted procurement programs.

“We see this as an economic development tool, to increase competition to do infrastructure work in this country,” Washington said. “If we knock down some of the barriers for historically underutilized businesses, then they can compete.”

The increased competition leads to taxpayer savings, Washington added. That is proving out in the efforts of San Francisco-based Merriwether and Williams Insurance Services, a project coalition member. Merriwether and Williams offers various programs to help historically underutilized businesses compete for public contracts.

Public agencies that have sponsored the bonding program have saved more than \$22 million as a result of low bids from participants, said Ingrid Merriwether, president of aligned risk management for the firm. It makes the idea of removing barriers, helping small businesses, and increasing competition an easy sell.

“I can't tell you how many construction department leaders have said to me, ‘Well, if what you can do can bring me more bidders, I'm all for it,’” Merriwether said.

# Thousands of Jobs and Hundreds of Housing Units at South L.A. Costco Groundbreaking

Los Angeles Mayor Karen Bass joined state and local leaders to recognize the groundbreaking of a new project that will bring more jobs, housing and resources to South Los Angeles. The project will add thousands of construction and permanent jobs, 800 new homes and a Costco with a healthy foods grocery store and pharmacy among other resources. This is a first-of-its-kind project for the City of Los Angeles that will accelerate the building of more much-needed housing.

“We are breaking with the old ways of doing things and moving Los Angeles forward. Unprecedented action driven by collaboration in both the public and private sector is what is expected and that's what we are delivering today. I used to live just minutes from here — and I know the hundreds of housing units, the thousands of jobs and the new wave of resources that this project will bring to this community has potential to make a generational impact on this neighborhood,” said Mayor Bass. “I want to thank all the partners who worked together to achieve today's milestone. This is about delivering for the

people of Los Angeles, and we will continue this urgent work.”

This first-of-its-kind project, 5035 Coliseum, is entirely privately financed with no public funding. The project will create a mixed-income community with nearly 200 units being affordable housing. Thousands of good paying construction jobs will be created. The project will include stores to serve the community, including the first Costco in South L.A which is set to have healthy foods, pharmacy, optical services and most onsite. The Costco store is expected to create 400 jobs alone.

“The new local jobs and the first-rate shopping experience will be a great addition to the community,” said Los Angeles City Councilmember Heather Hutt. “And importantly, new quality apartments will help improve residents' quality of life and help Los Angeles continue to make progress in addressing the housing shortage.”

“Everyone wins with this first AB 2011 project approved for the City of Los Angeles. It has all the elements we expected to see, including affordable and workforce housing along with jobs
